

CHILDREN'S RUGBY LEAGUE RECEIVES CONTINUED SUPPORT FROM REDHALL NUCLEAR

Redhall Nuclear has sponsored Barrow-based Hawcoat Storm Rugby League for the second year running. The support comes as a direct result of a request from Chairman and Head Coach Mark Burrows, who is also Project Controls and Delivery Manager at Redhall Nuclear.
