REDHALL SECURES A LONGER FUTURE AT TEESSIDE POWER STATION

Middlesbrough-based Redhall Engineering has signed a contract with GDF SUEZ to work as the managing contractor at Teesside Power Station.

The multi-year deal will build on Redhall's existing relationship with the power station, delivering term maintenance, projects and outages for the foreseeable future.

Tony Jester, Operations Director for Redhall Engineering, commented: "For the last six years, both as Redhall and prior to that R Blackett Charlton, we have had up to 70 personnel working at the power station, providing project engineering, outage planning, line management and mechanical and fabrication services on a 24-hour, 365 days-a-year basis. This latest contract will see a significant expansion of our onsite service provision together with the direct management of a number of key subcontractors."

Redhall Engineering employs over 1,800 staff working throughout the UK, providing engineering services to the oil, gas, chemical, petrochemical and power sectors. The company's northern office, which employs around 500 personnel, is based in Middlesbrough and has grown rapidly since it was established in 2004.
